Qualitative Proposal

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- 1. Give background of the study (State the problem)
- 2. Describe the need and value
- 3. Write your research questions **
- 4. Write an outline of relevant literature (Max 1-2 pages, min 6 sources)
- 5. Detail your methodology **
 - a. Describe why you pick the chosen methodology, support this with relevant literature including supporting your conceptual framework/theory
 - b. Population/sample/sampling (make sure this is a clear plan that you could hand to someone else and that they would be able to run with).
 - c. Potential instruments, equipment, people (man power if needed), and potential risks for failure (what could go wrong). How would you get permission for instruments or locations (if needed).
 You do not need to create an entire codebook or interview protocol, but be sure to discuss it (What would you do). If you pick interviews or open ended surveying,
 I want you to write five questions. If you choose observations based on your setting create five codes and define them in a manner that is clear to a research assistant. (In either case, ensure that your questions help answer your research questions.)
 - d. Give a realistic timeline for completion. Be descriptive in your steps. (Table format with bullets is fine.)

Keep this project under 10 pages, likely this should be about 5-8 pages.
